- More than half of online students still live less than 50 miles from campus.⁶

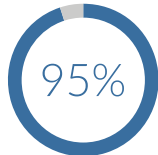

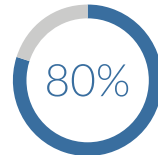


Going Back to School

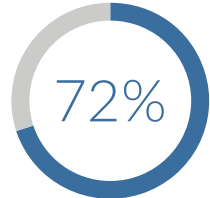

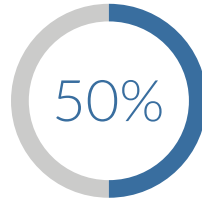

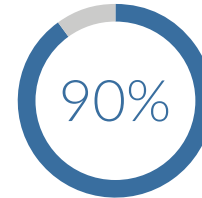

2. Introduce yourself to your instructor and your classmates and communicate.



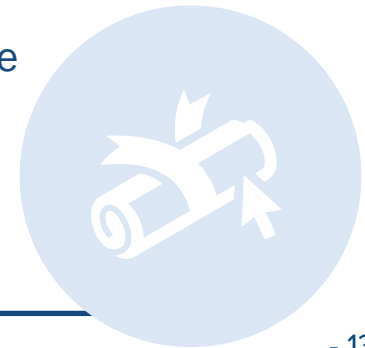
